species spotlight: Keel-billed Toucan

he beautifully colored Keel-billed Toucan is a gregarious rainforest dweller that ranges from Southern Mexico through Central America and into parts of Columbia and Venezuela. The Keel-billed Toucan, also known as the Sulphur-breasted Toucan or the Rainbow-billed Toucan in parts of its range, is common enough in the country of Belize to have been chosen as their national bird.

Keel-billed Toucans, like many other toucan species, live in social family groups of about six to 12 birds. They are a very vocal species and their loud call has been compared to that of a frog croaking. This unique call can be heard up to half a mile away! Keel-billed Toucans are monogamous and generally like to nest in tree cavities where they will typically lay up to four eggs.

The 43 species of toucans in the world are widely recognized for their extremely large beaks. Their beaks are uniquely adapted to foraging for fruit in the rainforest. Their long beaks can snip fruit from small stems while their heavy bodies are perched lower or higher on much sturdier branches. Although their beaks may look exceedingly heavy,



they are surprisingly light because they are made from keratin and have a honeycomb pattern with air spaces. They also have a very long tongue that runs the entire length of their beak and has a "feathery" end that helps to catch food and fruit juices.

Although the destruction of rainforests in Central and South America has caused a decline in numerous bird species, the Keel-billed Toucan seems to be doing well in its range. It's up to all of us to make sure to do all we can so that the Keel-billed Toucan and other rainforest species can keep flying free in the wild. Remember — recycling one can saves toucans!
